Burnaby Village Museum

Friday, July 20, 10:45am to 3:00pm

Cost: Members \$38; Non-members \$48

We're off to the Burnaby Village Museum "where history comes to life". Our day will start with a fish and chips lunch (included in price: includes fish and chips, coffee or tea, and pie for dessert).
