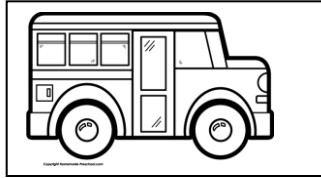


## LVSA BUS TRIPS FOR September and October 2023

**BARD ON THE BEACH** with Enjoy Tours (12 seats available)  
Sun. Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> 11:45 am – 5:45 pm  
Cost: Member \$149.00 Non-member \$159.00

Celebrating its 34<sup>th</sup> season in 2023, Bard on the Beach is Western Canada's largest not-for-profit, professional Shakespeare festival. It is Shakespeare meets the Beatles, with "As You Like It", set in Vancouver with a Beatlemania twist. Package includes theatre admission to the 2 pm show and picnic table lunch by Emelie's.

**MAPLEWOOD FLATS WALK AND LUNCH** Wed. Sept. 13<sup>th</sup> 10:00 am - 2:15 pm

Join in on a nature walk around Maplewood Flats which overlooks Burrard Inlet followed by lunch at Northlands's Bar & Grill (not included in price). Maplewood Flats is a 126-hectare conservation area in North Vancouver for bird watching, managed by Wild Bird Trust of BC.
