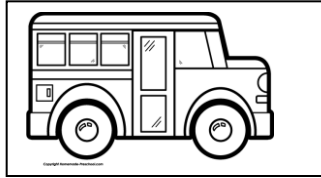


## LVSA BUS TRIPS FOR May and June 2023

### A VISIT TO BURNS BOG IN DELTA

Wed. May 10<sup>th</sup> 8:45 am – 2:30 pm

Cost: Member \$28 Non-member \$38

We will drive to Delta Nature Reserve where we will have a guided tour of Burns Bog “the lungs of the Lower Mainland” This unique ecosystem is the largest raised peat bog and largest undeveloped land mass in North America. Following our tour we will drive to the White Spot in Delta for lunch (not included in price) before returning to the North Shore.

Walkability: Lots of walking on wooden boardwalk. Participants must be able to walk 3-4 kilometers.
