Britannia Mine Museum & Howe Sound Brewery

We will enjoy a scenic drive to Squamish, stopping at Howe Sound Brewery for an early lunch, a tour and tasting of their craft beers. (Lunch is not included in price, 18% gratuity will be added for groups). We will then travel to Britannia Mine Museum, once the largest copper mine in the British Empire. In its 70 year life people from more than 50 nationalities lived and worked here. We will have a one hour guided tour, and an hour to explore interactive exhibits. Please bring sturdy footwear and warm clothes. There are 48 steps up to the mine tunnel for the guided tour. There are also narrow windy stairs for the Brewery tour.
