Burnaby Village Museum

Thursday, May 25, 10:15am to 3:45pm

Cost: Members \$15; Non-members \$25

The Burnaby Village Museum site is set in the 1920's, a place where pictures of King George V and Queen Mary are hung in the school house where the Union Jack hangs over the site. We will spend four hours strolling the streets of the village, stepping in and out of the buildings to watch demonstrations and talk to the costumed townsfolk and stopping for lunch at the Ice Cream Parlour (not included in price). There are limited food services on site so you may bring your own lunch. Lots of walking, you may bring your walker.
